Many kids will not immediately go to their parents or tell an adult that they are being bullied until it's too late. 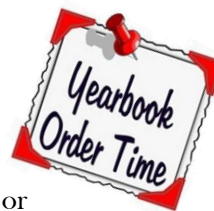
