Oroville, CA – On October 20, 2020, the Oroville Police Department arrested an employee of Plumas Avenue School as a result of allegations of inappropriate activities with minors. At this time, the allegations do not appear to have occurred while the employee was present on campus. The employee was immediately placed on administrative leave and will remain on leave pending the outcome of the investigation.

TUESD responds to each and every reported act of misconduct seriously. The Oroville Police Department is responsible for the on-going criminal investigation. The school district will cooperate fully with the police department during the on-going investigation.

Due to the legal restrictions that surround school employee personnel issues and student family confidentiality, at this time Thermalito Union Elementary School District is legally prohibited from publically commenting on any pending disciplinary action.

TUESD has no greater priority than the safety of our students. We do not tolerate conduct from any individual that compromises student safety or betrays the trust placed in our professionals. We remain committed to taking all necessary actions to ensure that our students are educated in a safe environment.
